To navigate through the NCLB Report Card, please see the instructions below.

Information on these report cards includes:

- Assessment results for the LEA and campuses in the aggregate and disaggregated by race/ethnicity, gender, disability status, migrant status, English proficiency, and economically disadvantaged showing two-year (2007-2008 and 2008-2009) trend data for each subject and grade tested:
  - by performance level,
  - with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group, and
  - including the percentage of each group of students not tested.
- Graduation rates for secondary school students.
- Performance of school district and campuses on adequate yearly progress (AYP) measures.
- Number and names of Title I schools identified as in need of improvement, including the stage of improvement and AYP indicator missed by any schools identified for improvement.
- Professional qualifications of teachers in the LEA and campuses, including the percentage of teachers teaching with emergency or provisional credentials and the percentage of classes in the LEA and campuses that are not taught by highly qualified teachers, including a comparison between high- and low-poverty campuses within the LEA.

**To navigate through the state, district and campus levels, see below:**

**State Level:** You will need no district or campus codes to navigate through this section.

**District Level:** You will need our district code (101906) or district name to navigate.

**Campus Level:** See directions below to navigate through the Campus Level.

To navigate through the Campus Reports section of the NCLB Report Card, please refer to the following hints:

When you are looking at the 'Campus Reports' on the NCLB Report Card, you will have the following page come up. In order to navigate through the 'Campus Reports,' you can type in the campus name or the campus ID number. Campus names and numbers are as follows:

For example, enter the above names or campus numbers when you see a page like the one below:

NCLB Report Cards at the campus level can be obtained for a selected campus. Using this page, you can view the NCLB Report Card for a campus that you select from a list. You may qualify the list by campus name or by campus number.

**To download an NCLB Report Card for a selected campus, begin the process by selecting from the options below.**

1. Select year.

2. Specify the selection method (i.e. by campus name or by campus number ) and optional qualifier to produce a list of campuses from which you can select.



Select by campus name;  
and, if you like, qualify the list by entering any characters contained in campus name (up to 34).

or



Select by campus number;  
and, if you like, enter the leading digits of the number or the entire number.
