The TAKS test is a very important examination that students have been preparing for all year. We are proud of their hard work! It is now time for them to show how hard they have worked each day.

On the TAKS testing day, students will have breakfast in the classroom. The breakfast will consist of a sausage and biscuit, juice, and milk. The lunch menu will be tamales, fiesta rice, seasoned pinto beans, and Scooby Doo snacks.
