This semester students will be participating in the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS). The TAKS test is a State developed assessment that is required by both State and Federal law. The dates of the tests are as follows:

April 28th: (Staff In-service) TAKS
Tutorials 8 A.M. until Noon.

April 29th: 10th Math TAKS, 9th & 11th
Required All-Day Attendance

April 30th: 11th Math TAKS, 9th & 10th
Required All-Day Attendance

May 1st: 9th Math, 10th Science, 11th
Science

May 2nd: 10th & 11th Social Studies, 9th
Required All-Day Attendance

Seniors arrive at 9:15 A.M. on Friday.

It is extremely important that your child perform to the best of his/her ability. To stress this importance, the State has included an honor statement that each student will sign prior to taking the test. Also, do not schedule any appointments during the school day for the four testing days above. Students must remain in class throughout the duration of the test day.

It is important to note that all grade levels and test subjects are equally important. If you feel that your child could benefit from additional support and is not currently attending TAKS tutorials, then please contact the school or your child's subject teacher for tutorial opportunities. Lastly, **cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed during testing**. All electronic devices will be collected before the test and later returned to the students to ensure that tests are not invalidated. Unfortunately, Crosby I.S.D. is not responsible for lost or stolen phones. It is recommended that electronics are kept home during all TAKS testing days.

On Tuesday, April 30th through Thursday, May 1st, Seniors who have taken and passed all sections of TAKS must enter through the doors by the Senior parking lot and sign in between 8:00 A.M. and 8:30 A.M. Failure to do so will result in an absence being recorded for that particular day. **Seniors must arrive by 9:15 A.M. on Friday, May 2nd.**
