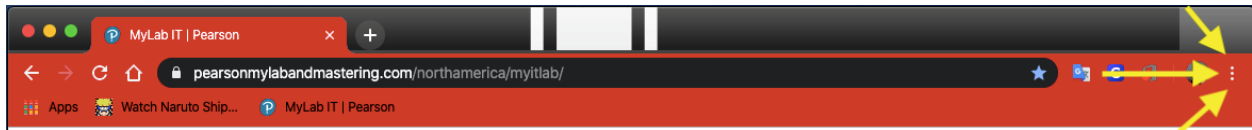


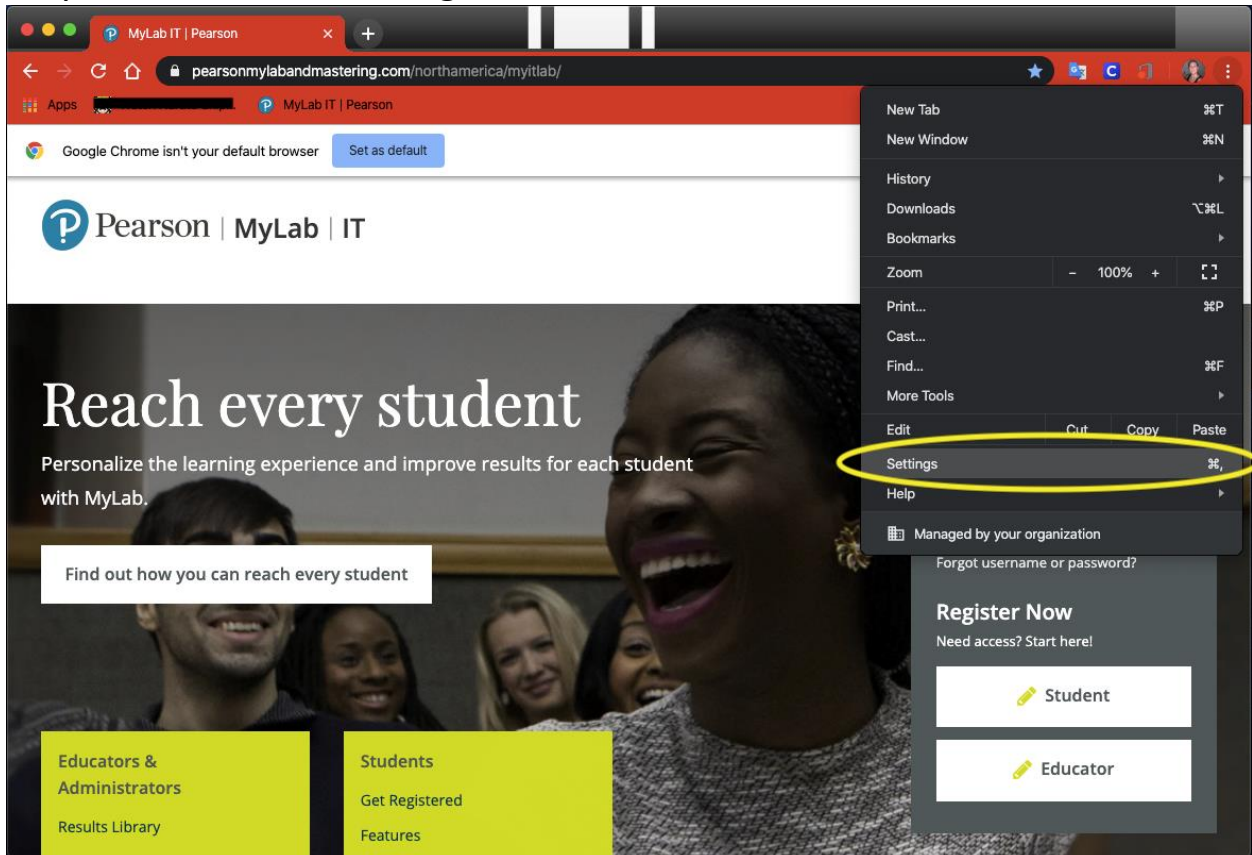
How to install Flash on a MacBook in Chrome

For Chrome:

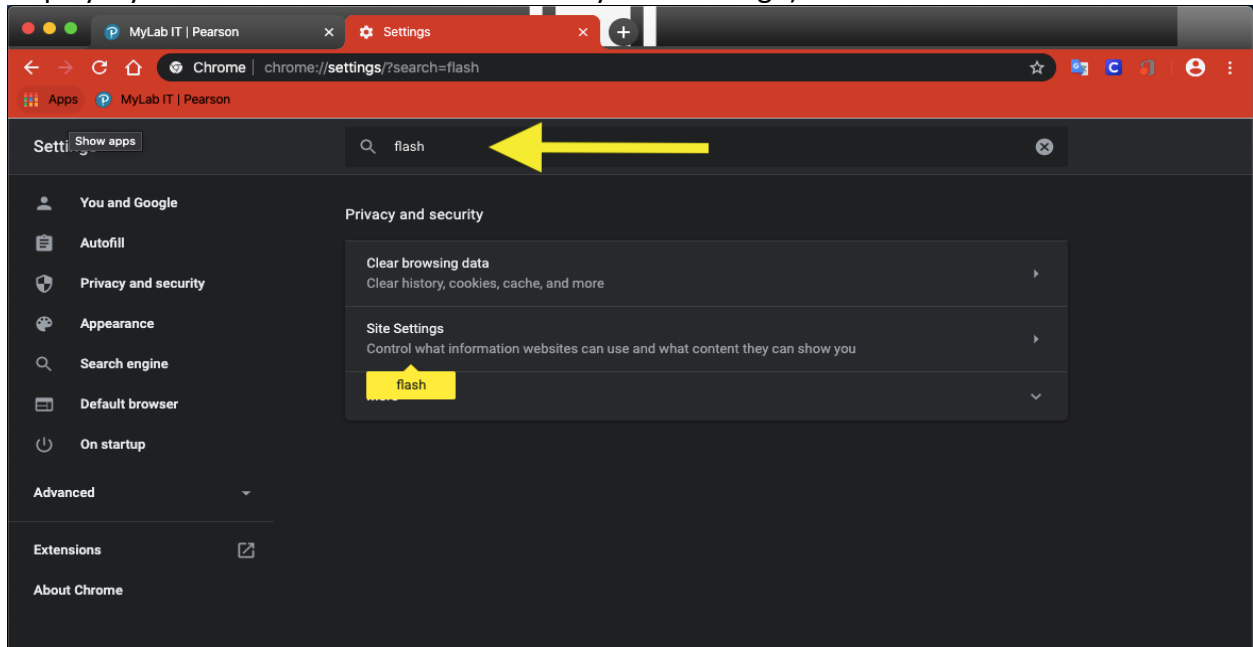
Step 1: Go to the 3 dots on the right-hand area, to the right of your address bar. Click the 3 dots.



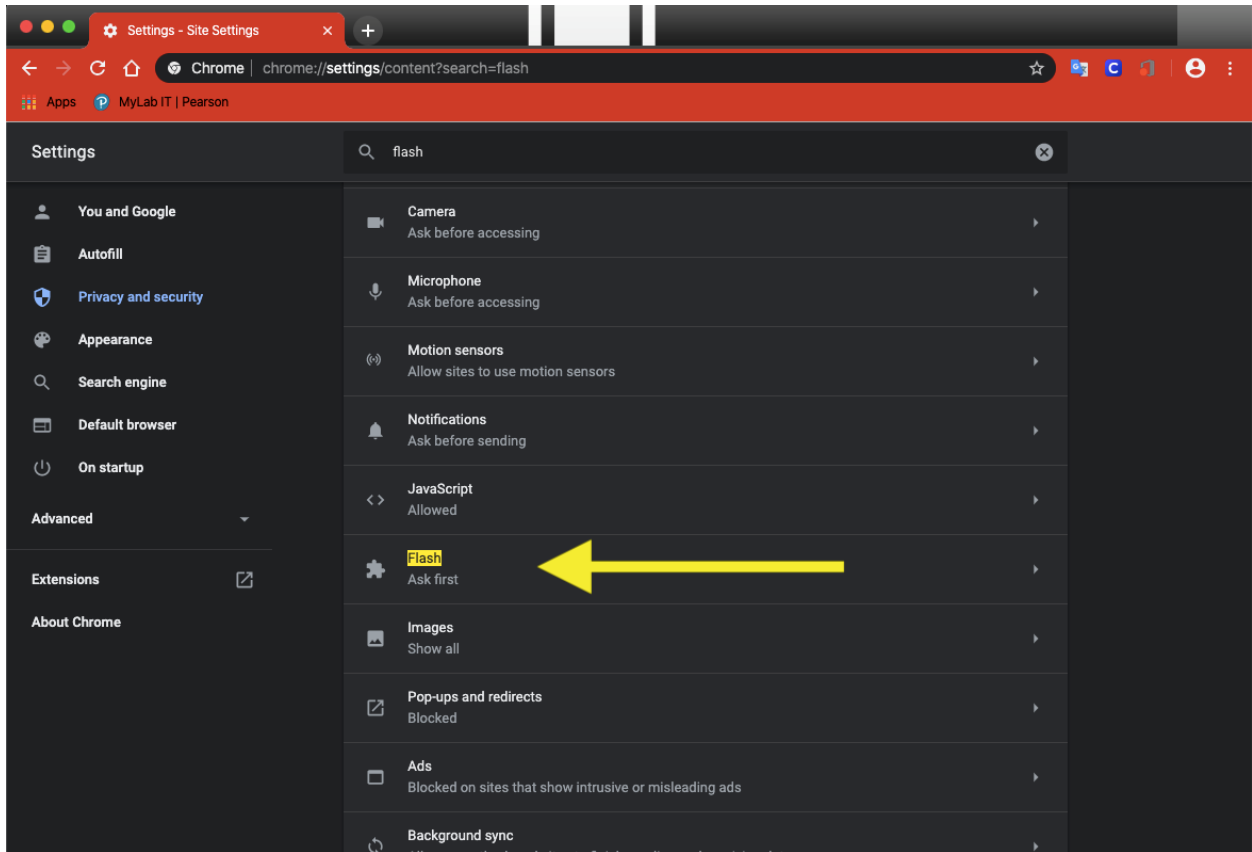
Step 2: Go down to settings and click it.



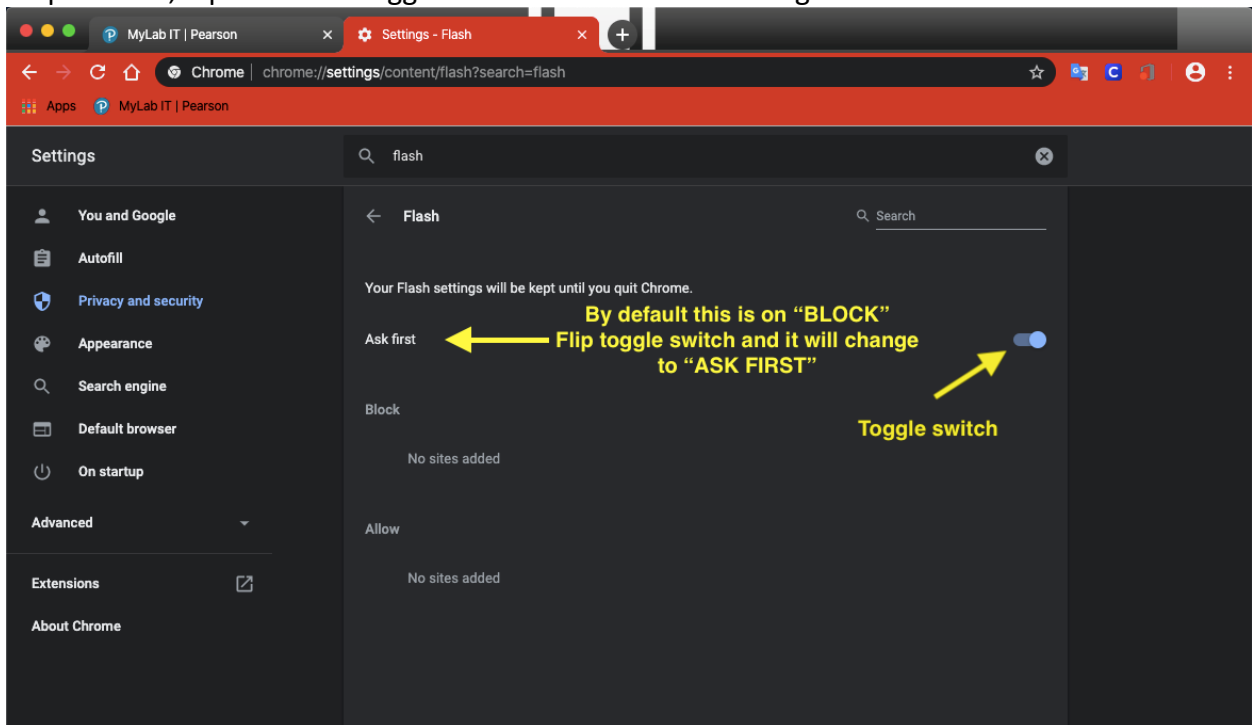
Step 3: At the top you have the empty bar with “search settings” in it the magnifying glass. In that search area, you can type “flash”. Click on Site settings or Content Settings (The search will display a yellow box with an arrow on where you need to go).



Step 4: Then scroll down until you see where flash is highlighted. Click the highlighted setting.

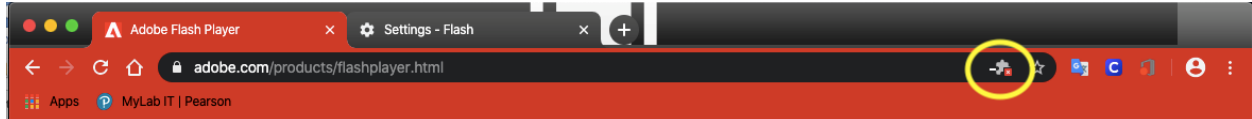


Step 5: Then, flip that little toggle switch. You will see it change from block to ask first.

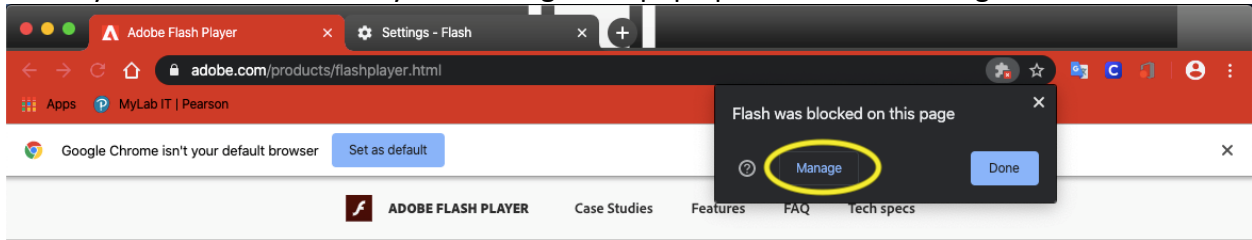


Then you can try to refresh that webpage and see if you get the pop up or little pop up bar at the top of the website maybe by the address bar and see if it asks you to enable flash.

There may even be a puzzle piece looking icon in the web address area that you can click on and enable flash.



When you click on the Puzzle you should get the pop up below. Click Manage.



After clicking on Manage you will be taken to the screenshot you see above in Step 5.
