#### MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 3. Work as a server on the serving line.
- 4. Assist in dish room, pot and pan areas; sweep and mop floors.
- 5. Assist in cleaning of equipment and the general kitchen/dining room areas.
- 6. May be asked to assume responsibilities of other absent employees.
- 7. Work schedule may be adjusted on an as needed basis.
- 8. Perform other assigned duties that may be required by the manager and/or the Director of Child Nutrition Service.
