As the 2014-2015 school year is nearing an end, we start looking toward the new school year with much enthusiasm. Crosby is growing rapidly and safety for our students is always our top priority. With that in mind, we wanted to inform you in ample time of a change that will be made starting at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year.

Starting next school year, we will no longer allow daily changes to be made to students' bus pick-up or drop-off locations. Approximately, 86% or 4700 of our 5500 students ride a school bus everyday. Not only do these daily changes of students' routes make our system of transportation inefficient, most importantly it creates an unsafe system for our students. One of our greatest fears is that somehow we will lose a student. The chances of this fear becoming a reality are greatly increased when numerous students' pick-up and drop-off locations are changed on a daily basis.

Please note that we will continue to allow students to be changed from a bus rider to a car rider.

Although there are districts in our area that require the same pick-up and drop-off address, Crosby ISD students may designate a pick-up location that is different from their drop-off location. The pick-up and drop-off locations can continue to be home, grandparents, day care, etc., but they must be the same everyday. Any change of address throughout the year will be considered a permanent change.

These measures are taken to protect our students, help our schools, and help our transportation department provide the safest transportation services possible.

We thank you for your understanding and support as we make this transition for the 2015-2016 school year.
