

2015-2016 TAX LEVY ORDER AND RESOLUTION

AN ORDER AND RESOLUTION FIXING AND LEVYING SCHOOL DISTRICT AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CROSBY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016, AND DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Crosby Independent School District finds that the tax for the fiscal year 2015-2016 hereinafter levied for current expenses of the District and the general education of students within said District and for the improvement of the District and its property must be levied to provide the revenue requirements of the budget for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of said District further finds that the taxes for the fiscal year 2015-2016, hereinafter levied therefore, are necessary to pay interest and to provide the required sinking fund on outstanding bonds of the District issued for school purposes, and on bonds proposed to be issued for such purposes during the ensuing year.

NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the **CROSBY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS**, that:

Section 1. For the current expenses and maintenance of the Crosby Independent School District and for the carrying out of its educational function and for the general improvement and maintenance of its property, there is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected for the fiscal year 2015-2016 on all property situated within the limits of the said Crosby Independent School District of Harris County, Texas, on January 1, 2015, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, **an ad valorem tax at the rate of One Dollar and Seventeen Cents (\$1.17) on the One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of such property.**

Section 2. For the purpose of paying interest and providing a sinking fund for the payment of each issue of bonds issued for various school purposes including the various installments of principal falling due during the ensuing year on serial bonds issued for such purposes, and for the purpose of paying interest and making provision for the sinking fund on such bonds as may be issued for various school purposes during the ensuing year, there is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected for the fiscal year 2015-2016 on all property situated within the limits of the Crosby Independent School District of Harris County, Texas, on January 1, 2015, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, an ad valorem tax for each of the issues of bonds and capital expenditures, **the sum of said respective levy fifty hundredth Cents (\$.50) on the One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of such property.**
