## Why do we need a 4.0 GPA calculation?

A growing number of colleges and universities are utilizing the GPA provided by individual districts, regardless of the calculation method.

Historically, postsecondary institutions would re-calculate GPA based on a 4.0 scale to even the playing field when making competitive scholarship and admission decisions among students from different districts. As college admissions applications are increasing each year, many universities will not take the time to re-calculate.

School district GPA calculation methods are determined by each ISD; therefore, no uniform method exists across districts

## What does this mean for students?

- Rigorous calculation methods may reflect high standards for the districts' students but may inadvertently place them at a disadvantage when compared to students who graduate from other districts.
- Many internships and scholarship applications require a 4.0 GPA and will not recalculate the weighted GPA reflected on the transcript. Therefore, our students are being passed over for important job and financial opportunities.

## Process

- 4.0 GPA will be included on each student's transcript along with the current Crosby ISD GPA used to calculate rank
- The 4.0 GPA will be in addition to and will not replace the current Crosby ISD GPA used to calculate rank
- Students will have the option of using the 4.0 GPA or the current Crosby ISD GPA when applying for scholarships and college entrance
- The 4.0 GPA will utilize the following calculation methodology used in most colleges and universities
- All courses that contribute to high school graduation requirements will be included in GPA calculations
- Courses that do not contribute toward graduation requirements (e.g. office aide) will not be included in GPA calculations
- The setting of the course – online, summer, etc. – does not exclude the course and will be used in GPA calculations
