## Approved Project List

- 1. Rate the Book! You may choose to do a very short online book review (on CMS Library webpage) on each of the three books you read or you may use the hard-copy book review form. (Please see Ms. Henderson).
- 2. Wordcloud Create a "Wordcloud" image based on the book you can use words, themes, character names from one of the books you read. (Suggested wordcloud tools: Wordle or Tagxedo)
- 3. Playlist Create a playlist for the main character of the book. What songs would the main character listen to? Use playlist.com or other music app to create a playlist or simply write a list of songs that you think the main character would have on their playlist.
- 4. Illustration Create your own illustration for the book this can be a drawing of a particular character or moment in the book; or can be based on the overall story. Drawings may be done using your choice of materials.
- 5. Graphic Novel Panel Create a comic strip panel depicting a part of the book. Include a minimum of 5 boxes with pictures and dialogue done in the style of graphic novels.
- 6. Movie Poster Create a movie poster for the book you read. If your book were to be made into a movie, what do you think the movie poster would look like? Include: movie title, actors to play leading characters, illustration representing the movie based on the book.
- Book Trailer Create an online mini commercial about your book, sort of like a movie trailer. Tell your audience why they should read the book. (Please see Ms. Henderson.)
- 8. Create an illustrated timeline showing important events from the book. Choose at least 10 important events from the story. Write a description of each event, and draw & color an illustration for each event. The events must be in the order in which they occurred.
- 9. Make a map of places where the story took place. The map should be colored. Write a description of what each place is and why it is important.
