

Crosby ISD Nutrition Services will proceed with the following COVID Meal Distribution Plans to ensure students of the area have food security during the 21-22 School Year.

Child Nutrition Services <u>Remote Learning</u> Meal Plan

- All students selecting remote learning will have access to food through the regular Nutrition Services program.
- To participate in meal service, individuals are required to pick up meals every day from their assigned campuses during normal meal service times.
- Waivers from USDA will allow students to consume meals offsite during the 21-22 school year.
- Waivers from USDA will allow parents to obtain meals without students present; however, parents must provide proof of student enrollment such as id badge, name card, or student id number.
- Regulations prevent duplicate meal distribution; therefore, if the parent does not have the card, name, or student is not present, no meal will be served.
- All meals will exceed USDA nutritional requirements.

Child Nutrition Services <u>Campus Learning</u> Meal Plan

- Students selecting campus learning and wanting to participate in meal service are required to pick up meals in the cafeteria during scheduled mealtimes and consume meals in designated locations.
- All students will be encouraged to use scanned badges when collecting meals.
- Meal Service times are based on the academic schedule for each campus.
- Meal service will start Thursday, August 12, 2021.
- Meal distribution in cafeteria lines will have the following process to decrease risk of exposure:
 - All lines will have access to hand sanitizer at the entrance of the cafeteria.
 - All lines will have shields in compliance with Harris County Department of Health and Human Services protocols to decrease cross contamination.
